What I do know is that many of those at Grace Church, who work tirelessly as unpaid staff, handling our finances, paying our bills, managing payroll, and taxes have been praying with the whole church for God to help us adjust to the loss of saints who were tithers and strong financial contributors to Grace Church's general fund and ministries, who went to heaven in the last several years.

Some may not know that Mary Ahlborn, our finance chair, has worked on our budget and finances for years. Over the years that I have served at Grace Church, beginning with 2009, we have had devoted and able treasurers who work hard to keep us going. When I came here in 2009 Paulette Pinkerton was our solo treasurer. Then Cindy Yeager joined her, and their team served years. Currently, Barb McCoy and Donna Layne are doing an admirable job as treasures and are supported by Paulette working on taxes, and Aileen being trained to help with bill paying. <u>No one would imagine how many hours are spent handling the finances of a church, even one the size of Grace Church.</u> In addition to the finance leadership team, every Monday two volunteer servants come in to count and record the offerings. Thank you to all our financial servant team!

<u>Grace Church is an amazing little church who does outreach ministry in our community at a</u> <u>level that far exceeds our numbers or resources.</u> In addition to the finance leadership and counters Grace Church members continue to pledge their time and giving to keep Grace Church moving forward in ministry.


