Romans 13:8, "Let no debt remain outstanding, except the continuing debt to love one another, for they who love their fellowman have fulfilled the Law."

Wednesday, February 14th is Valentine's Day and Ash Wednesday. It seems very fitting that Valentine's Day and Ash Wednesday should be on the same day. Valentine's Day is a time to recognize the people in our lives that we love and that love us. I have fond memories of making a Valentine box as a child to put on my desk to receive my Valentines. I remember the care I took signing my Valentines and picking out the ones I liked best to give to the kids I liked best. Valentine's Day was special because everyone tried to communicate love and care for others.

Ash Wednesday was not an event that I observed as a child. When I attended church, which was seldom, I attended a Baptist Church, and they didn't observe Ash Wednesday. I think Ash Wednesday of 1972 was my first Ash Wednesday service which I attended at St. John's Lutheran Church, where Dan and I were married on August 11, 1973. It was at St. John's that I learned that there is one spiritual law that is the fulfillment of all other laws. In **Galatians 5:14**, we read the entire law is summed up in a single command; "Love your neighbor as yourself." Further in **Romans 13:10** we read, "Love does no harm to its neighbor."

Real love, Godly love, cannot harm its neighbor because Godly love is never selfish. Godly love cannot harm any more than the sun can produce darkness instead of light. In 1 John 4:8 we read, "God is love." Consider 1 John 4:10, 19, "This is love, not that we loved God... We love God because God first loved us."

Truly, loving anyone as it is described in 1 Corinthians 13:4-8a, and 13 means that, "Love is patient and kind, love is not jealous or boastful; it is not arrogant or rude. Love does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; it does not rejoice at wrong but rejoices in the right. Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. Love never ends. So, faith, hope, love abides, these three; but the greatest of these is love."

This Valentine's Day please come celebrate Ash Wednesday, either at 11:00 A.M. or 7:00 P.M. We will be celebrating the kind of love God has for us that allows us to love one another and to love our neighbor as ourselves. This is the kind of love that God gives us is life giving and cannot be diminished or destroyed even by death. When God fills us with Godly love, we can love each other, now and forever
