FEED MY SHEEP

In 2008, Carolyn Stegner recognized that there were many people in Springfield in need of a meal. She felt that God was speaking to her and she listened and responded. Carolyn and her husband, Fred, started the Springfield Soup Kitchen. She began preparing food in her home and in 2009 the meals were served in the basement of the former St Mary's Catholic Church at 1027 W. High St. The need was great and the numbers of people being served increased. A move to a larger place was necessary. The ministry then moved to it's current location at 830 W. Main St. They serve meals on Monday and Wednesday from 5:00 pm—6:00 PM. Currently they average 200 meals served each day. Carolyn responded to God's call to "Feed My Sheep" and did so until she passed away. Her Husband, Fred, continues to work to expand the Soup Kitchen and with help from volunteers from all denominations and faiths, the ministry has grown to meet the needs of the hungry and homeless in our community.

The Soup Kitchen also opens as a Warming Center in the winter months and provides items such as coats, sleeping bags and blankets to people who are homeless. This organization also owns the parking lot across the street from the Soup Kitchen and there is currently an area there that the homeless use to put up a tent. There are several people living there because the shelters are full. Fred provides a warm place for people to come for a cup of coffee, warm food and to fellowship together. The Soup Kitchen welcomes volunteers and is always in need of the following items: 6-8 oz Styroform cups, paper plates, forks and spoons, 2 ply napkins, plastic gloves, large kitchen trash bags, aluminum foil, plastic zip lock bags and large commercial cans of food.

The Women's Group at Grace Church has invited Fred Stegner to come speak at the church on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>February 15 at 12:00 noon</u>. He will speak about the Soup Kitchen. This program is open to all who are interested in learning more about this vital ministry located right in our neighborhood. We would like to give some of the needed items listed above to Fred after his presentation. If you would like to donate, there will be a box in the hall across from the bathroom. Please pray for the many people who depend upon the Soup Kitchen to survive and for the volunteers who keep the ministry alive and growing in our

community.


