

ALL CHURCH MEETING 3-10-2022

The meeting was opened with devotions and prayer by Robert Keeton.

The secretary report from the October meeting was reviewed.

The April calendar was reviewed adding Easter basket assembly from ten to twelve on the seventh and trustees at six on the seventh.

He has applied for a grant to run a summer program based on non-fiction that would run from July 11 until the start of school.

Pennies Plus: Dave is sending 24 cards to church people and 15 of his own outreach.

<u>Finance</u>: Donna and Barb reported that we have our heads above water after having to borrow from the Edward Jones account. We are at a good point where we are able to pay bills early. It is still to be determined where the Easter collection will go.

Youth: Pastor Vicki reported that we have no youth right now, but we have the leader and the facility.

<u>SPPRC</u>: Pastor Vicki reported that there is nothing happening right now.

<u>Trustee</u>: Pastor Vicki reported that we still do not have a head trustee. She is acting in that position as of now.


