Psalm 96, "Sing to the Lord a new song; sing to the Lord, all the earth! Sing to the Lord, praise his name; tell of his salvation day to day. For great is the Lord and most worthy of praise."

All 150 chapters of the Book of Psalms found in the Old Testament are poetry. The Hebrew title of Psalms means "songs of praise," while the Greek title is "Psalmoi," which means sacred songs sung to musical accompaniment. Many contemporary Christian worship songs come from the Psalms. That is especially true of Christmas and Advent Carols.


This year during Advent and Christmas I invite you to sing the songs with Jesus. Jesus keeps us on key and in rhythm. Jesus' presence helps us keep the busyness of the holidays in the proper perspective. When we sing with Jesus, his joy will fill us and overflow to those around us that we want to bless during this holy season. From the first singing of the Advent Carol, "Prepare Ye the Way of the Lord," to the singing of "Silent Night," Christmas Eve the music draws us together. The music unites us as people of faith and as disciples of our Lord Jesus, whose birth we celebrate each Christmas.

During the Christmas season we decorate the church and our homes, we put up trees and hang wreaths, buy gifts and wrap them. We send cards and receive them. We bake treats and get together for parties. All these activities are part of our Christmas celebrations but not the most important part. The most important part is our worship during Advent when we prepare our hearts to receive anew the gift of Jesus our Savior. Jesus is the most cherished Christmas gift- full of forgiveness and eternal love. It is our Heavenly Father who sent the gift of Jesus to save all of humanity from the wages of sin. God has given us a Gospel gift that shall last forever. John 3:16 says it this way, "For God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten son that whosoever believes in him shall not perish but will have everlasting life."

It is because of God's Gospel gift of Jesus that all the other activities of Christmas make sense.

At Christmas we have a unique opportunity to be made new. As we sing, decorate, bake goodies, and worship together let us remind ourselves with each activity that Jesus is with us whenever we invite him. As we worship and sing our favorites, "O Come, Oh Come, Emmanuel," "O Little Town of Bethlehem," "Away in a Manger," "Angel's We Have Heard on High,"" O Come, All Ye Faithful," "Hark! The Herald Angel's Sing," and "Joy to the World," we open our hearts that God may bless us with a deeper appreciation of the real gift of Christmas, Jesus.

Advent books are available for you as a gift from Grace Church, so that we can read and sing together this year. Once every 6 years we have Christmas Eve on Saturday and Christmas Day on Sunday. Christmas Eve services are 7:00 PM and Christmas Day Sunday service is a 9:30 AM. We will be doing something special for Christmas morning (No sermon) as my gift to you.
