ALL CHURCH MEETING, MAY 11, 2023 - GRACE UNITED METHODIST CHURCH

David Speas, Chairman, opened the All-Church meeting with devotions and prayer. The minutes of the April meeting were approved as read and filed for audit. Calendars for June and July were reviewed and approved.

Barbara McCov presented the Financial Report for April – May 11, 2023. All bills are paid. The Easter offerings of \$1,139 will be used to pay District apportionments. Proceeds for the Community Bean dinner were \$840.61 and will be transferred to the general fund. The Upper Room subscriptions fund is in arrears (these devotional books are mailed to shut-ins). Recycling of aluminum cans and donations support this fund.

Pastor Vicki Downing announced that Pattie Mumma has resigned as Office Manager. Aileen Wasser has been hired to replace her. A farewell social will be held for Pattie on May 21st.

Pastor Vicki and Betty Prosser recommended that the All-Church meetings should be cancelled for June and July. All agreed.

Pastor Vicki said that beginning in July 2023 the Miami Valley District will be renamed as the Western Lake District with Jim Wilson as Superintendent. The West Ohio Conference is extending boundaries under its jurisdiction while reducing the number of Districts from eight to six.

She also announced that the 2023 West Ohio Annual Conference will be held on June 1st and 2nd at the Dayton Convention Center, Dayton OH. Mary Beth Cheeseman, a former member of Grace UMC, will be ordained during the Conference.

Connie Mitchell, Outreach Chair, reported that we are partnering with Snyder Park School to help support their field day with bottles of water and cookies plus other activities as needed. Pastor Vicki recommended that the monies in the Youth Fund should be used for this ministry. All agreed. Grace members serving at the Springfield Soup kitchen has begun. At least four servers will be needed to serve each second Monday. Pastor Vicki is setting up a prayer table for participants for the Monday Grace volunteers serve. The church has joined the Care -Portal network (Nehemiah Foundation). Baby bottles from the Pregnancy Resource Center Fund Raiser are available for the congregation to fill with loose change between Mother and Father's Day.

Pat Hart spoke on behalf of the Trustees that the problem with the hot water temperature has been resolved. The business office has been moved downstairs to the lounge. The move was made to reduce utility bills. The flower beds are in need more upkeep.
