Lately, I have been thinking about how many people are lonely and feel isolated. Two things prompted me to think more about loneliness and isolation. First, several church members and several people from the community have called recently wanting to talk about loneliness and isolation. Second, my beloved husband, Dan, died unexpectedly on March 29.

I have always felt sympathy and empathy for people who are hurting. I will admit I now have a much deeper understanding of what loss, loneliness, and isolation feels like. I am one of the fortunate ones, I have family, friends, and our Grace Church family, who have all been a great support to me. Still, none of this support helps much when I roll over at night and see that Dan isn't there.

Many people became lonelier and more isolated during Covid. I think many of us are hungry for fellowship. When Grace Church scheduled a painting class, 21 people signed up. I think we need to work together to find more ways to be together in community. It will help us as individuals and as a faith community to support each other and share God's love.

1 Peter 4:8, "Above all, keep one another earnestly."

One of the ways that we can feel closer to each other is to pray for each other daily. When I was at South Park United Methodist Church a group gathered weekly, each opened our pictorial directory and prayed silently for each person or family. This can also be done at home. I am asking for helpers to work with me to plan monthly fellowship gatherings, so we can spend more time together. If you are interested in serving on this fellowship team, please contact me.

Another way we can feel closer is to serve together. Each month on the first Tuesday of the month we make laundry soap in our kitchen. Grace Church has produced and distributed over 14,000 gallons of laundry soap in the Springfield community. Each month on the second Monday we help serve food at the Springfield Soup Kitchen. It's hard to feel lonely and isolated if we stay busy and engaged. If you want to be more involved, let someone know. Sharing rides to help with activities is an option. At the end of the school year a Grace Church team baked 600 cookies and attended Snyder School's Field Day, giving out smiles, cookies, and pop cycles. More details of upcoming ministry's efforts will be available soon. Connie Mitchell, our Outreach Chair, is always dedicated to finding new ways to serve. Let's get involved, let's try to help ourselves be less lonely and isolated.

2 Corinthians 5:17, "If anyone is in Christ, he or she is a new creation, the old has gone, the new has come!" May God bless us everyone.


