Philippians 4:8, "Brothers and sisters, think about the things that are good and worthy of praise. Think about the things that are true and honorable and right and pure and beautiful and respected."

This is a favorite scripture of mine. I believe this is powerful and effective instruction for us as we seek to become the people God wants us to be. TANGY BROWN PORK CHOPS

2 LB, (approx. 6) pork chops	2 Tbsp brown sugar
Salt and pepper to taste	1 tsp prepared mustard
1 onion, chopped	2 (8 oz) or 1 (15 oz) can tomato sauce

2 Tbsp vinegar

Place meat in baking dish. Sprinkle with salt & pepper. Bake 45 min at 375: drain fat off. Combine onion, vinegar, sugar and mustard. Spread on meat. Pour on tomato sauce. Bake at 350 for 30 min or until done, basting occasionally with sauce.
